Benefits of Membership: Many local events are open to all members of the MAA - some with no or reduced entry fees. These include Art and Wine Strolls, Peddlers Fairs, Plein Air activities, Chalk Art Street Fair, SWAN Day, our annual Art in the Park event on the third Sunday in August, the Holiday Boutique, and many others. As a member, you are invited to participate in rotating art exhibits with various local businesses in downtown Martinez. Newsletters and “calls for artist” are sent to our members, as well as public announcements of community art events that MAA members participate in.

Volunteer: The MAA board members are all volunteer positions. We welcome and value members who volunteer their time in the planning and execution of our organization’s annual art events. The success of these fundraising events allows for the continuation of the MAA’s grant and scholarship program.
